### Celestial Cinema

The Maui Film Festival at Wailea's "crown jewel" venue is an under-the-stars open-air Dolby Digital equipped "theater" that features Premieres and Special Advance Screenings on a 50' wide screen. Each night's film is preceded with a chant, hula or mele (contemporary song) and a tour of the night sky by Maui Film Festival astronomer Harriet Witt.

### SandDance Theater

The Festival's "toes-in-the-sand oceanside theater" on Wailea Beach (below The Four Seasons Resort Maui at Wailea) celebrates the history of cinema with silent film screenings and live musical accompaniment.

Up-on-the-Roof Premieres, Special Screenings, and lively discussions on the future of cinema at the rooftop garden of the Wailea Marriott, an Outrigger Resort.

### Taste of Wailea, Taste of Chocolate & Starry Night MoonDance

The culinary artists of the Wailea Resort present the Taste of Wailea, a food and wine-tasting par excellence considered among the best in Hawaii. What grew out of that desire has become The CandleLight Cafe & Cinema, Maui's "Weekend-in-the-Middle-of-the-Week", an every Wednesday TwiLight (5pm) and StarLight (7:30pm) Special Screening at the Maui Arts & Cultural Center's Castle Theater, with an opportunity to hear live music, flirt and enjoy dinner and

dessert between shows at The Center's Founders' Courtyard. The Festival also hosts FirstLight, a Holiday Season event, from mid-December to early January each year, that features advance screenings of virtually all of the film industry's end-of-the-year Academy Award worthy releases. Complimentary admission to most major film industry guild members. The event is also open to the public. Rounding out the Festival's annual schedule is each October's Sports & Shorts Festival.
